## HOW TO MEASURE YOUR RING SIZE

To determine your size, we strongly advise that you measure the size of your finger rather than the size of your ring.

- 1. Using a length of string or ribbon, wrap it around the base of your finger. To ensure the ring fits comfortably, we suggest measuring your knuckle as well. We recommend selecting a size that will slide on and off your finger easily.
- 2. With a pen, mark the point on the string where the end meets.
- 3. Measure the string in millimeters with a ruler or a meter.
- 4. Choose the closest measurement to the chart above to identify your ring size.

TIPS

The sizer must fit snugly to produce an accurate size.

Finger size can change depending on the time of day & weather, for the most accurate measurement, measure your finger across multiple times of day, and on multiple different days to compare.

Avoid measuring your fingers when they are cold or wet, as they will be at their smallest.
